Scratch Players World Amateur Ranking: 277

He competed in all the team's matches as a freshman and had three top-10 finishes, including fifth at the Tavistock Collegiate Invitational. Named to the Pac-10 All-Freshman team. Scoring average of 71.95 was fourth-best in school history for a freshman. ... Andersen won the Arizona Stroke Play championship and qualified for the 2017 U.S. Open, placing second at the sectional.

Eric Ansett, Lipscomb University

Second on team in scoring average (72.0) and had five top-10s, including a T-4 at Windon Memorial. ... One of the top juniors to come out of Australia, he won the South Australian Junior and the Malaysian Amateur.

Christian Bosso, University of West Florida

World Amateur Golf Ranking: 712

Played in the No. 2 spot and helped West Florida reach the NCAA Division II championship match, where they lost to Lynn. The junior finished T-16 at the Gulf South Conference Championship and was selected to the All-Gulf South Conference team.

Colin Bowles, Ohio State '18

Competed in the 2017 Dogwood and finished T-31. Will be a freshman at Ohio State in the fall. Won the 2016 Georgia Amateur Championship to become the second-youngest winner since Bobby Jones won the inaugural event in 1916. Former West Virginia Junior Champion who once shot 56 at Clearfork Valley Golf Course, a course owned by his brother. His father is owner of River Pointe Golf Course in Albany.

Konrad Brauckmeyer, Santa Clara '19

Hometown: Lima, Peru

Finished 6th at 2018 Peru International Amateur. Won the 2018 Pacific Alianza Cup – Peru and 2017 Peru International Junior. Has qualified to play in Peru Open, an event on the PGA TOUR LatinoAmerica in each of the last three years. Committed to Santa Clara program that qualified for the NCAA Regionals this season.

Nick Budd, Georgia State University

Hometown: Woodstock, Ga.

Golfweek/Sagarin College Ranking: 390

A rising senior at Georgia State, Budd was second on the team in scoring average as a junior (73.17). He had two top-10s and finished-39 at the Sun Belt Championship. Was named All-Sun Belt third team as a sophomore when he was third on the team in scoring and earned his first collegiate win. Tied for 23rd at the 2017 Georgia Amateur Championship.
